### CHARLES NEWMAN JR., M.D. Newman Plastic Surgery

When patients enter the office of Newman Plastic Surgery, one thing is clear—they feel welcome and comfortable.

But, to Charles Newman Jr., M.D. and his staff, that is just the beginning. “I feel the office environment is a reflection of our approach to our practice,” says Dr. Newman. “Most of our patients comment how warm and inviting our office is and how we’re readily available to meet their needs.”

The practice began two years ago with Dr. Newman working alongside his most trusted confidant, his wife and physician assistant Dizi Newman, P.A.-C. “When we first started out, it was just the two of us. We were sharing office space with Dr. Leonard Levine, a plastic surgeon who has since retired.” While Dr. Newman continues to see Dr. Levine’s former patients, the practice has quickly established its own identity. Despite the growth, the essential attitude of the practice remains the same: quality relationships with patients and delivering the highest quality results.

While Dr. Newman performs all facets of cosmetic and reconstructive surgery, most of his practice focuses on breast and body contouring procedures. Dr. Newman specializes in breast augmentation, breast lifts and reductions, and abdominoplasty (tummy tucks). “There are several areas such as the eyelids or nose where subtlety is the key. Other areas, such as the breast and abdomen, dramatic changes can be achieved through surgical intervention,” he says. Many women are discouraged by the changes in their breasts, abdomen and lower body after pregnancy, while other patients have lost hundreds of pounds, sometimes through bariatric surgery. Dr. Newman particularly enjoys the unique challenges these patients present. “Restoring the youthfulness of the abdomen and breasts and returning them to a previous state is very exciting,” he says, “and I share this enthusiasm with my patients.”

Dr. Newman, who is board-certified by the American Board of Plastic Surgery, is dedicated to the treatment of breast reconstruction following mastectomy, as well as to the diagnosis and treatment of skin cancer. “The restoration of form and function is critical to these patients, and it is very rewarding to be a part of this transformation.”
